We are looking forward to an exciting, productive and learning-filled year. After a complete refit of the heating/colling system in the school, the custodial staff have done an amazing job of getting the school clean and sparkling in the short window they had in the last weeks of August. ### The following gives information and procedures for the Day 1, Tuesday Sept. 3rd:

- 1. School hours for first day are **8:30-11:00 am**. Supervision will be provided outside beginning at 8:10 am. Students are encouraged to bring a morning snack.
- 2. **Kindergarten students** will begin attending school with our gradual entry schedule that begins Wednesday Sept. 4<sup>th</sup>.
- 3. **Grade 1 6 students** will line up outside their last year's classroom for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> days of school. Class lists will be posted at the front of the school, and returning students are asked to line up at the exterior doors where they traditionally entered the school last year.
- 4. **New students** to the school will be asked to enter through the front doors and check the bulletin board **in the library**, to see which classroom they have been assigned to. Staff will assist in this area to help new families know where to line up.
- 5. Your patience is appreciated at dismissal time. We ask that the parents/guardians of primary students wait for the teachers to dismiss children one at a time in order to ensure everyone connects safely with the person picking them up.



# For Day 2, Wednesday Sept. 4th:

We are hoping to get all our **Grade 1-6 students** into their new classrooms with their new teachers before the end of the day, Wednesday Sept. 4<sup>th</sup>. **Signboards will be outside at the end of the morning to let parents know where to collect their children at 2:30 pm.** Staff will be outside to help with any questions.

Just a reminder that the school parking lot is for staff only, and parents should not be entering the school lot to drop off or pick up students. The preferred option when dropping off or picking up your children is to park away from the site, and take a short walk to the gates. We have an arrangement with Mission Springs Church of God on Casorso Rd. allowing us to use their parking lot as a student drop-off site, giving students a short walk to the school.
